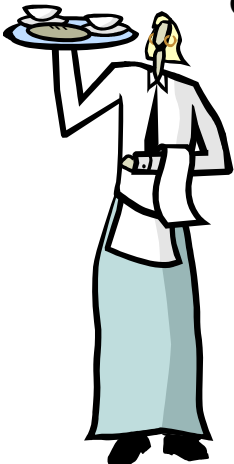

Please invite your friends and neighbors. They always have plenty of food!

CALVARY WAFFLE SHOP

Waiters and waitresses from Saint Andrew's are needed at the Calvary Waffle Shop every weekday during Lent.
