- 1) Opening devotional Field Norris
 - September, Joe Lee Rape
 - October, John Russell
 - November, Kent Thompson
- 2) Approval of minutes from the June 24th vestry meeting
 - Approved by all
- 3) Financial review & discussion
 - Fifth month of coronavirus, but good news is our reserve is more than our remaining budget
 - YTD looks good
- 4) Discussion of how re-opening is going
 - We're keeping an eye on attendance and maintaining spacing; use of masks is 100%.
 - Father Jeff and Father Christian will make sure to be aware and take responsibility for announcing when we have too many and need to move to parish hall
 - Last two weeks we've been around 115, had been as low as 80
 - Potential to consider doing services outside in the Fall
- 5) Discussion of current project to improve our online presence
 - John and a group exploring options, video option for a church our size is an iPhone or iPad
 - Online content Father Jeff and Father Christian are creating is really good
 - Identified Church Solutions website software that is easy to use, not super expensive and really connects with our app
 - o Biggest benefit is it will be easier to change than current website
 - Tom is researching a video camera that is not really expensive that can be controlled by an iPhone or iPad and can sit on a tripod. This would wirelessly stream to Facebook, YouTube, etc.
 - Tom is working on an extender for wireless because signal drops sometimes and need it to be stronger for video
 - Comcast tech is coming out Friday to look at the service
 - Father Jeff said daily online viewing is between 90 140 and the services have around 200 viewers

- 6) Discussion of ways to do more and better in-reach
 - Since we can't really get people together, Rachel is going to take on calling people in the parish
 - Father Jeff and Rachel will discuss topics to touch on during the conversations
 - EYC is still going on, but Jill is resigning this month; Julie is staying on. Average youth minister lasts 3 months, they have been doing it for 12 years
 - Christian will take it on
 - Our choirmaster Jeremy Warner is leaving
 - He is going to Germany after Sept 6, returning in December
 - o In 2021 he may be gone for 6 months
 - Need to consider whether we should continue the position, as he was hired as a choir director and we don't have a choir (not to mention the frequent traveling)
 - May want to find someone who can cantor, and we can supplement with choir members
 - o Father Jeff got consensus from the Vestry how to proceed
 - Father Jeff will talk to Jeremy this weekend, and then we can determine how to move forward
 - Need to look hard to find 3 Vestry candidates to fill the roles of the 3 members who are rolling off; asked everyone to prayerfully consider strong options
 - John Russell, Mary Walton Allen, and Gina Harden will serve as nominating committee
