August 2021 Vestry Meeting Minutes Aug 11, 2021 at 7:00 PM

Attendees: Father Jeff, Father Christian, Cynthia Carpenter, Field Norris, Laura Hall, John Russell, Rita Compton, Stacy Coughlin, Ken Blankenship, Davis Woods, Jenny Cordell, and Kent Thompson

- 1. Devotional time led by Kenneth Blankenship. Devotional assignments for remainder of year:
 - Sept: Thompson
 - Oct: HallNov: Woods
- 2. Approval of minutes from Jun 9th meeting.
 - Motion made and approved by all
- 3. Financial update/review Fr. Jeff Marx.
 - Discretionary funds are going quickly; currently out until November
 - Will recommend at some point that we do something with the Memorial Fund
 - Actual income was 15% below budget; YTD actual and budget right on
- 4. Discussion about music Davis Woods.
 - Davis offered to personally fund singers to perform the Hallelujah Chorus at the Christmas Eve services
 - Davis and Cynthia will check with Vernon to see how many people are needed and if they can make it work
 - John pointed out that there currently aren't enough people to make up the choir, especially with no Director, and he misses it and hopes it comes back
 - However, until things are stable again, won't be able to get back to "normal"
- 5. Buildings and grounds update/input Kenneth Blankenship.
 - Security Fire came today and will do a proposal for a 5-year inspection of the sprinkler system, would be about \$2,500
 - The Fire Dept. is focusing on it this year, so it needs to be done
 - June 16, replaced outdoor conditioning unit and both disconnects
 - While replacing it, realized the circuit breaker needs to be replaced and Banks Electric will come out to do that work
 - Cynthia said there are several spots out front that are missing grass; will investigate
- 6. Other business.

- Asked if we will renew being a "shelter partner" in the event of crisis/disaster; they reimburse damages and/or excess utility charges
 - Father Jeff said yes, with restricting access to the alter and requesting there be adult supervision in the kitchen
 - Motion to renew was made and approved
- First Wednesday is scheduled for Sept 1 for evening prayer and dinner
- The week after Labor Day Father Jeff will start the Wednesday bible study again and potentially a book study if there is interest; Father Christian will also start his bible study
- The Collierville police department asked pastors around town to help them deliver/participate
 when they have to deliver news of death or difficulty; 10 pasters including Father Christian were
 trained and will be on call for this
- Davis brought up recent situation where someone was needed to run camera and stream service, but only a couple people know how to do it
 - John mentioned that Tom and Vince proposed getting an iPad and setting it up with directions so anyone can run the camera and stream services
