- 1. Devotional time led by Steve Anderson a reading from *The Will of God*.
 - a. Devotional assignments for remainder of year: Oct-Bailey; Nov-Monette
- 2. August Vestry Minutes approved unanimously.
- Monthly and Annual P&L and Balance Sheet review conducted by Martha Lendermon.
 - a. Although August contributions were slightly lower than budget, the annual remains better than budget.
- Vestry nominating committee reported that 10 potential candidates have been contacted about serving. Ultimately, they will have three nominees.
- 5 delegates and 2 alternates are needed for the Diocesan Convention Nov 18–19.
 To date, we have 4 delegates and still need one more, plus a couple alternates.
- Father Marx provided a job description for the Sexton position and reviewed it.
 Discussion on various aspects, including compensation. Securing the position and posting is moving forward.
- Father Marx brought up the potential of widespread food shortages and security issues.
 - a. Members discussed the various ways to support parish members during a food shortage.

- Kent Thompson gave a brief synopsis of the recent security meeting with
 Lt. Herring, Collierville Police Dept., attended by approximately 20 parish members.
- c. Father Marx proposed instituting a Safety Committee. Its purpose would be to provide oversight of injury, health, fire, etc. of parish members while on property.

- b. Regarding the transept window project, it has been decided to not go with the window and associated expense, but rather to just plaster and paint over.

- 10. Other Business: Brief discussion of the Collierville Literacy Council by Davis Woods. Motion made and approved to provide \$5000 contribution.
