Ride on triumphantly! Behold, we lay our lusts and proud wills in Thy way!

(Jeremy Taylor was a cleric in the Church of England who achieved fame as an author during the Protectorate of Oliver Cromwell. Note that Saturday, Aug 13, is his Feast Day in our Liturgical Calendar.)

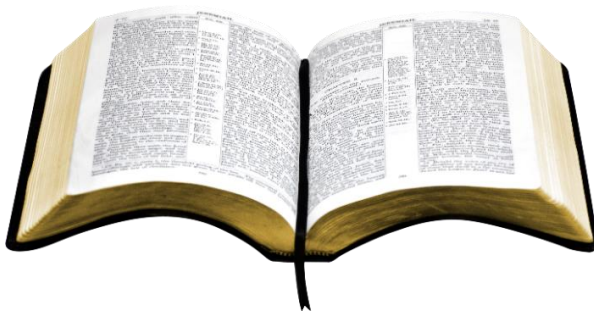
