NOTE FROM FR. JEFF ABOUT VESTRY NOMINEES: We need 3 new Vestry. If you are a confirmed communicant (over 18 years of age) and have been a member of the parish for at least 2 years, **you** are invited to run – or to identify a candidate and ask them to run – or to say yes if someone approaches you to run. The Vestry must ensure we have at least 3 candidates, but you are the source of candidates. Please pray that the Lord's hand will guide this process. The Vestry nominating committee is composed of Bill Barnett, Charles Hall, Keena Meinhart, and Joe Stinnett. They welcome you to approach them about this process. Parish members aged 16 and over can vote at the annual meeting on Wednesday, Dec 4.
