## ANNOUNCEMENTS

**AUGUST GIVING TO SUPPORT COLLIERVILLE FOOD PANTRY:** August is Saint Andrew's month for helping support the Collierville Food Pantry. Write your checks to Saint Andrew's with a memo of "Food Pantry." The EYC will shop for food and deliver it. The Pantry is always so appreciative.

**KROGER REWARDS PROGRAM:** We got an update from Kroger regarding our parishioners' use of Kroger Plus cards. We'll all order and pay for our own individual dinners as we socialize with our fellow parishioners in a wonderful setting. That night we'll give our much-appreciated First-Wednesday volunteers a needed break. Sign up in the parish hall by Sunday, Sept 1; however, let us know by Wednesday, Aug 28, if you will need childcare at the church.

Any flower contributions exceeding \$90 will be placed in the altar fund.

**NOTE FROM FR. JEFF ABOUT VESTRY NOMINEES:** We need 3 new Vestry. If you are a confirmed communicant (over 18 years of age) and have been a member of the parish for at least 2 years, **you** are invited to run – or to identify a candidate and ask them to run – or to say yes if someone approaches you to run. The Vestry must ensure we have at least 3 candidates, but you are the source of candidates. Please pray that the Lord's hand will guide this process. The Vestry nominating committee is composed of Bill Barnett, Charles Hall, Keena Meinhart, and Joe Stinnett. They welcome you to approach them about this process. ### **NOTE TO POTENTIAL SERVICE PARTICIPANTS**
