PRE-LENTEN RETREAT: Saint Andrew's will have a pre-Lenten retreat on **Sunday, Feb 20**, shortly after the end of the 10:30 service. It will be led by Fr. Jeff. The theme is "Setting a Rule of Life." The goal is to help people make concrete plans for how they want to improve their personal level of "life function," with Lent serving as a time to make measurable commitments. Sessions will cover different areas such as the physical, prayer life, self-knowledge, relationships, church membership, discipleship, and evangelism. It will end by 3:30 or 4:00 PM, so it will not be too complex or over-involved. Lunch will be provided (soup, salad, sandwiches), with a suggested donation of \$5 for lunch.
