ALTAR FLOWER SIGN-UP: The **2022** sign-up for altar flowers is posted on the bulletin board in the parish hall. The cost of altar flowers is \$90 for one person requesting a particular date, or \$45 each for multiple persons requesting a particular date. Any flower contributions exceeding \$90 will be placed in the altar fund.

CHURCH CALENDARS: The **2022** Saint Andrew's Church Calendar is available for parishioners on the hallway bookshelf near the office. With the days and seasons reproduced in the proper liturgical colors, these calendars are helpful daily guides for orderly observance of the Church Year. The back of each sheet has Sunday RCL readings and Holy Day readings as well.

PRE-LENTEN RETREAT: Saint Andrew's will have a pre-Lenten retreat on Sunday, Feb 20, shortly after the end of the 10:30 service. It will be led by Fr. Jeff. The theme is "Setting a Rule of Life." The goal is to help people make concrete plans for how they want to improve their personal level of "life function," with Lent serving as a time to make measurable commitments. Sessions will cover different areas such as the physical, prayer life, self-knowledge, relationships, church membership, discipleship, and evangelism. It will end by 3:30 or 4:00 PM, so it will not be too complex or over-involved. Lunch will be provided (soup, salad, sandwiches), with a suggested donation of \$5 for lunch. Multiple **sign-up sheets** are available on the parish hall bulletin board and on the white table beside the ushers' table in the sanctuary. Please sign up as soon as you can, the main reason being to get a count of the children — possibly a separate session or activity can be set up for them.
